SERMON SERIES ON LUKE: GOD THE SON, SON OF MAN DECEMBER 24, 2022

The Birth of Jesus Christ

Many incredible miracles and events happened around Christ's birth. But all of them relate to the Divine purpose of His coming. They show us that what God wills, God fulfills.

How did God bring about His purposes at the birth of Christ?

GOD USES THE PERFECT TIME (Luke 2:1-3)

 God came into our broken world at a time of peace, just before the population explosion of the first century, when innovations would hasten the spread of the Gospel, and the world's brokenness by sin had reached its height. Our God indeed makes everything beautiful in His time (Ecclesiastes 3:11).

Galatians 4:4-5 "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons."

GOD RAISES THE RIGHT PEOPLE (Luke 2:4-5)

- God raises the right people and forges their destinies so they can serve Him. Though both were recipients of grace, and though the reasons for being hand-picked by God are unknown to us, Mary and Joseph were people of character. Matthew 1:19-20, 24 reveals the righteousness, compassion, and obedience of Joseph. Luke 1:38, 46-47 reveals the faith, humility, and salvation of Mary.
- God raised you up for a purpose. Are you ready to fulfill your calling?

GOD CAUSES THE BEST CIRCUMSTANCES (Luke 2:6-7)

• Jesus was not born in Nazareth, or He would have never fulfilled the prophecy. Jesus was not born in a palace, or He would have been followed for the wrong reasons. Instead, He was born in the humblest of circumstances to a faith-filled teenager, to be raised by a father who had decided to sacrifice everything in obedience to God.

The life of a Christian is never left to chance. If we cannot believe that God only wants our good in the midst of what He causes or allows, what chance of peace or hope do we have?

FINAL THOUGHTS

How God brought about His plan for Christ is no different from how He works in our lives as Christians. May the way that God came through to give us Jesus remind us that God accomplishes what is best for us in His perfect way and time. Always. ■

Our Glorification of Jesus Christ

One of the greatest proofs that Christ is God, and is, therefore, our only Savior and Lord, is how He was glorified by angels from the heights of heaven, all the way to the least-regarded men on earth.

For "what is the chief end of man? To glorify God and enjoy Him forever" (Westminster Shorter Catechism).

Knowing that to glorify and enjoy God is our reason for existence – on this day in the year above all – how do we glorify our Lord Jesus Christ?

LIKE THE ANGELS, WE CAN PUBLICLY TESTIFY ABOUT CHRIST TO THE GLORY OF GOD

What is worth testifying about?

- The Great Joy that Jesus brings. "Good news of great joy for all the people." (Luke 2:10)
- His Salvation and Lordship that give us Joy. "For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord." (Luke 2:11)
- The Peace with God that Jesus brings. "Peace among those with whom He is pleased." (Luke 2:14)

LIKE THE SHEPHERDS, LET'S GATHER TO WORSHIP AND THEN GO OUT TO SERVE

- True worship means that we joyfully give what is costly to us: our presence, our effort, and our time, among others. That's what it cost the shepherds. Let's not give God what costs us nothing.
- After we have experienced the heights of worship, the time comes for us to return to our callings and serve God there. How? By glorifying and praising God "for all we have heard and seen" – God's grace and mercy shown to us personally.
- What is the outcome of God-pleasing service?
 "And all who heard it wondered at what the shepherds told them." (Luke 2:18)
 "But Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart." (Luke 2:19)

FINAL THOUGHTS

From the highest heights of heaven to the least-regarded on earth, God is glorified in the worship of Christ. This Christmas Day, may your life be recommitted to the worship of the One who, while we were yet sinners, came on earth to die for us. ■

THE GOSPEL

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord Almighty, the whole earth is full of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3). He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess. With your mouth. 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).

Lord Jesus, be merciful to me. a sinner. I believe that You are the Son of God who took the penalty for my sins on the Cross. I humbly ask You to be mv Savior and submit to you as my LORD forever. Amen.
