THE "ONE ANOTHER" COMMANDS OF THE BIBLE FEBRUARY 25-26, 2023

Living in Harmony With One Another ROMANS 12:16-21

Conflict between believers erodes our testimony as ambassadors of the gospel. The Devil will do everything to cause dissension and disunity in the church. The way to counter his schemes is the subject of our series on messages on the "One Another Commands" in the Bible.

We introduced it by talking about "The Blessings of Being One with One Another." We anchored it on the central command to "Love One Another" as the only debt we should owe to each other. Then we saw last time the command for us to "Bear with One Another in Love." Today we will take up the challenge of "Living in Harmony with One Another."

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO LIVE IN HARMONY WITH ONE ANOTHER? To be of one mind by avoiding pride and embracing humility...

"Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight." Romans 12:16

- a. In accord with Christ (Romans 15:5)
- b. In accord with the God of love and peace (2 Corinthians 13:11)
- c. In accord with the Spirit (Philippians 2:1-2)

2. WHAT SHOULD WE DO TO LIVE IN HARMONY WITH ONE ANOTHER?

- a. With our brethren in the church (Romans 12:10-13)
- b. With others outside the church (Romans 12:14-15, 17-20)

3. WHAT EMPOWERS LIVING IN HARMONY WITH ONE ANOTHER?

- a. A Genuine Love (Romans 12:9) "Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good."
- A Radical Faith (Romans 12:21) "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

As the Christian life begins with offering ourselves up to God as a living sacrifice, and transforming ourselves by the renewing of our minds, living in harmony with one another begins with an attitude of humility that leads to being of one mind; in accord with Christ, in accord with the God of love and peace, and in accord with the Spirit.

When this happens, then we can live both with those who are within the body of Christ, and even with those without. Empowered with a genuine love and a radical faith, we can serve the cause of Christ in society, which is the Great Commission, by living harmoniously with one another.

Ang alitan sa pagitan ng mga mananampalataya ay sumisira sa ating patotoo bilang mga kinatawan ng ebanghelyo. Gagawin ng Diyablo ang lahat para magdulot ng hindi pagkakaunawaan at pagkakawatak-watak sa simbahan. At ang paraan upang malabanan natin ang kanyang mga pakana ay ang paksa ng ating serye sa "One Another Commands" ng Bibliya.

Inumpisahan natin ito sa ating pag-aaral tungkol sa "The Blessings of Being One with One Another." Iniangkla natin ito sa pangunahing utos na "Love One Another" — ang tanging utang natin sa isa't isa. Ang pinakahuling utos na ating tinalakay ay "Bear with One Another in Love." Ngayon naman ay ating tatalakayin ang hamon na "Living in Harmony with One Another."

3. ANO ANG NAGBIBIGAY KAPANGYARIHAN SA ATIN PARA MAMUHAY NANG NAAAYON SA ISA'T ISA?

- Isang Tunay na Pag-ibig (Romans 12:9) "Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good."
- Isang Radikal na Pananampalataya (Romans 12:21) "Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."

Habang ang buhay Kristiyano ay nagsisimula sa pag-aalay ng ating sarili sa Diyos bilang isang sakripisyo at pagbabago ng ating sarili sa pamamagitan ng pagpapanibago ng ating kaisipan, ang pamumuhay na naaayon sa isa't isa ay nagsisimula sa isang saloobin ng kababaang-loob na humahantong sa pagkakaroon ng nagkakaisang pag-iisip; ayon kay Kristo, ayon sa Diyos ng pag-ibig at kapayapaan, at ayon sa Espiritu.

Kapag nangyari ito, maaari tayong mamuhay kasama ng mga nasa loob ng kapatiran, at maging kasama ng mga nasa labas. Sa pamamagitan ng kapangyarihan ng tunay na pagibig at radikal na pananampalataya, maaari tayong maglingkod sa layunin ni Kristo, na siyang Dakilang Utos, sa pamamagitan ng pamumuhay nang naaayon sa isa't isa.

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures," (1 Corinthians 15:3-4)

THE TRUTH ABOUT GOD

God is holy and righteous:
"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord
Almighty, the whole earth is full
of his glory" (Isaiah 6:3).

He requires holiness of us as well: "Be holy, for I am holy" (1 Peter 1:16).

THE TRUTH ABOUT CHRIST

Christ is the expression of God's love for us: "God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Romans 5:8). Christ paid the penalty of our sins and died for sinners: "For Christ died for sins once for all, righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God (1 Peter 3:18).

Through Christ, God offers man reconciliation: "God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them (2 Corinthians 5:18).

WHAT SHOULD WE DO? Believe and receive Jesus as Lord and Savior:

If you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord,' and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved" (Romans 10:9).
