COMMUNION SERIES ON LUKE: GOD THE SON, SON OF MAN

The Self-Revelation of Jesus

Though active in ministry at Capernaum (John chapters 1-4), Jesus had never given explicit details about His identity or calling. This passage is significant because of the clarity and directness of His self-revelation. It also highlights what would become a pattern of His life— proclamation, then rejection, culminating in His ultimate sacrifice. Unsurprisingly, this is often a pattern for a Christ-follower's life too:

The Empowerment of Jesus: He Served through the Power of the Holy Spirit (Luke 4:14–15).

• If Jesus needed the Holy Spirit on earth, how much more do we? (John 14:16–17; 26)

The Exposition of Jesus: He Spoke through the Power of the Word (Luke 4:16-27). The main points of Jesus' Message:

- a) Jesus is the promised Messiah of the Old Testament (Luke 4:16-21).
 - Isaiah 9:6
- b) Jesus is the rejected Savior of His own people (Luke 4:22–24).
 - John 1:11–12
- c) Jesus' salvation is offered regardless of race or social status (Luke 4:25–27).
 - John 3:16–17

The Execution of Jesus: He Survived by the Plan of God (Luke 4:28–30).

• In the same way, every Christian is immortal until God decides it's time to come home. Rather than inciting us to "test God" (imposing on Him how and when He keeps His promises) or to fear people and circumstances, this should make us rest in God for the present and hope in God for the future.

FINAL THOUGHTS

As we reflect on Jesus' life, let us recognize that our lives have power only from God's Spirit, our words have significance when based on God's Word, and we'll last as long as God's perfect plan intends.

"If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own; but because you are not of the world, but I chose you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. Remember the word that I said to you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' If they persecuted me, they will also persecute you. If they kept my word, they will also keep yours."

Ang Pagpapahayag Ni Hesus ng Kanyang Sarili

Nung huling pag-aaral natin sa Luke nakita natin kung paano sinubok si Hesus ni Satanas mismo, at kung paano Siya nagwagi sa pamamagitan ng kapangyarihan ng Espiritu ng Diyos, at paggamit ng salita ng Diyos.

Ngayon naman ay pag-aaralan natin ang mga talatang nagsasalaysay ng malinaw at matuwid na pagpapahayag ni Hesus ng Kanyang sariling pagkakakilanlan at pagtawag. Ginawa Niya ito sa Kanyang kinalakhang sinagoga sa Nazareth mga isang taon na sa Kanyang ministeryo sa lupa.

Makikita din natin dito ang magiging hubog ng buhay Niya—pagpapahayag kung sino Siya, tapos pagtanggi sa Kanya, hanggang sa Kanyang sukdulang sakripisyo sa krus ng Kalbaryo. Hindi tayo dapat magtaka na ganito rin ang magiging hubog ng mga buhay natin bilang tagasunod Niya.

- 1. Ang Kanyang Paglilingkod sa Kalakasan ng Diwang Banal (Luke 4:14-15).
 - Ito rin ang kailangan natin sa ating paglilingkod sa Kanya (John 14:16–17, 26).
- 2. Ang Kanyang Pamamahayag sa Kalakasan ng Salita ng Diyos (Luke 4:16-27).
 - Si Hesus ang Ipinangakong Mesias sa Lumang Tipan (Luke 4:16–21; Isaiah 9:6).
 - Si Hesus ang Tagapagligtas na Tinanggihan ng Kanyang mga Kababayan (Luke 4:22–24; John 1:9–11).
 - Si Hesus ang Tagapagligtas ng Lahat Anuman ang Lahi o Katayuan sa Lipunan (Luke 4:25–27; John 3:15–16; 1 Timothy 2:3–4; 4:10).
- 3. Ang Kanyang Pagkakatakas sa Kalakasan ng Kalooban ng Diyos (Luke 4:28-30).
 - Ito rin ang ating kaaliwan: na tayo'y ligtas sa kahit na anong panganib hanggang oras na nating umuwi sa Panginoon.
 - Ito ang ating katiyakan: na mamahinga sa Kanya ngayon, at umasa sa Kanya para sa kinabukasan.

HAMON

Sa salaysay na ito mula sa buhay ni Hesus, kilalanin natin na ang ating buhay ay may kapangyarihan lamang kung tayo'y puno ng Espiritu ng Diyos; may kahalagahan lamang kung nakasandig sa Salita ng Diyos; at may kahabaan lamang kung naaayon sa kalooban ng Diyos.

The Shepherd's Voice

Why Does GCF Ortigas Practice a Plurality of Elders?

The New Testament never mentions a one-pastor congregation. The Bible presents pastoral ministry as a team effort involving a plurality of elders in each local congregation. The Greek word for elder, "presbyteros," almost always occurs in the plural (Acts 11:30; 14:23; 15:2; 20:17; Titus 1:5; James 5:14). In Philippians 1:1, Paul addresses the believers by greeting "all the saints in Christ Jesus who are at Philippi, with the overseers [plural of episkopos] and deacons." Church ministry is always a team effort, though the specific roles of each leader will differ according to giftedness.

A church governed by a plurality of elders enjoys their combined knowledge, wisdom, and experience. It provides a wealth of counsel for shepherding the flock (Proverbs 11:14; 15:22) and, most importantly, protects the flock from the self-serving preferences of a single person.

Paul often commended his ministry co-workers. Some served as preachers and evangelists. Others supported the ministry in less visible ways, but all contributions were vital because their unique leadership roles contributed to the ministry's overall strength. Moreover, it protected against the self-serving, autocratic leadership of some like Diotrephes, who liked to put himself first, not acknowledging anyone else's authority (3 John v. 9). A plurality of elders is necessary because a "Diotrephes" may arise in any church.

At GCF Ortigas, please realize that we have elders on staff called "pastors." On the other hand, we have lay pastors we elect called our "Board of Elders." The only difference between these two teams is that our pastors (staff elders) are supported by the church, while our elders (lay pastors) support themselves. The expectations about time and effort are understandably higher for our staff elders. But both groups share equally in the vital task of shepherding together the GCF flock by devoting themselves "to prayer and the ministry of the word" (Acts 6:4). Always pray for your pastors and elders. We need it so crucially!
