ENGLISH MESSAGE OUTLINE

MOTHER'S DAY SERMON MAY 13-14, 2023

Someone to Watch Over You

GENESIS 16:1-14

One of the most significant women in the Bible was a foreigner working as a lowly servant, who was abused and taken advantage of in a system that worked against people like them. And this was by supposed people of God, Sarai and Abram.

Hagar not only receives the very first of fifteen appearances by the pre-incarnate Christ in the Old Testament (Christophany), but also has the longest conversation with God of all women! What do the major movements of the story teach us about God? What is the significance for Christian mothers, that there is a God who sees them?

HAGAR IS MALTREATED AND RUNS AWAY (Genesis 16:1-9)

- God always keeps His word, and when He said that He will bless the offspring of Abraham, that included blessing the child of Hagar too.
- Life is never easy, but rebelling and running from where you should be never solves the problem.

GOD NAMES ISHMAEL: "GOD HEARS" (Genesis 16:10-12)

- God hears the afflicted who have nowhere else to go: He stopped Hagar from trying
 to return to Egypt, and most likely from death along the way for her and the baby.
 Deuteronomy 10:18 (NASB) He executes justice for the orphan and the widow, and
 shows His love for the alien by giving him food and clothing.
- Will we see Hagar in heaven? I believe so! Maybe even Ishmael, the mistreated child who learned to pray at the point of death (Genesis 21:17), living up to the name that God gave him.

HAGAR WORSHIPS GOD AND OBEYS HIM (Genesis 16:13-14)

 "Truly here I have seen Him who looks after me." Hagar is the only person in the Bible who directly gives God a name: You-Are-the-God-Who-Sees. As a perpetual tribute to God, Hagar named the well in honor of "The One Who Lives and Sees Me."

FINAL THOUGHTS

The world tells us that "beauty is in the eye of the beholder." The Bible teaches something that far outweighs beauty and it is this: when God is your beholder, grace is in the eye of your Beholder. He knows what you have been through; He knows what you are going through. Mothers, you are never invisible to God. Trust the One who sees you. ■

MOTHER'S DAY SERMON MAY 13-14, 2023

Mayroong Magbabantay Sa Iyo

GENESIS 16:1-14

Ang isa sa pinakamakabuluhang babae sa Bibliya ay isang dayuhan na nagtatrabaho bilang isang hamak na lingkod, na inabuso at sinamantala sa isang sistemang lumalaban sa mga taong katulad nila. At ito ay nangyari pa sa ilalim ng mga tao ng Diyos na sina Sarai at Abram.

Hindi lamang natanggap ni Hagar ang pinakauna sa labinlimang pagpapakita ng preincarnate Christ sa Lumang Tipan (Christophany), ngunit mayroon ding pinakamatagal na pakikipag-usap sa Diyos sa lahat ng kababaihan! Ano ang itinuturo sa atin ng mga pangunahing paggalaw ng kuwento tungkol sa Diyos? Ano ang kahalagahan para sa mga Kristiyanong ina, na may Diyos na nakakakita sa kanila?

SI HAGAR AY MINALTRATO AT UMALIS (Genesis 16:1-9)

- Laging tinutupad ng Diyos ang Kanyang salita, at nang sabihin Niya na pagpapalain
 Niya ang mga supling ni Abraham, kasama na rin ang pagpapala sa anak ni Hagar.
- Ang buhay ay hindi kailanman madali, ngunit ang pagrerebelde at pagtakbo mula sa iyong nararapat na lugar ay hindi malulutas ang problema.

PINANGALANAN NG DIYOS SI ISHMAEL: "DININIG NG DIYOS" (Genesis 16:10-12)

- Naririnig ng Diyos ang mga naghihirap na wala nang ibang mapupuntahan: Pinigilan Niya si Hagar na bumalik sa Ehipto, at malamang sa kamatayan sa daan para sa kanya at sa sanggol. Deuteronomy 10:18 (NASB) He executes justice for the orphan and the widow, and shows His love for the alien by giving him food and clothing.
- Makikita ba natin si Hagar sa langit? Maari! Siguro kahit si Ismael, ang minamaltratong bata na natutong manalangin sa punto ng kamatayan (Genesis 21:17), na namuhay ayon sa pangalang ibinigay sa kanya ng Diyos.

SI HAGAR AY SUMASAMBA SA DIYOS AT SUMUNOD SA KANYA (Genesis 16:13-14)

"Truly here I have seen Him who looks after me." Si Hagar ang tanging tao sa Bibliya
na direktang nagbibigay sa Diyos ng pangalan: Ikaw-Ang-Diyos-Na-Nakakakita.
Bilang isang walang hanggang pagpupugay sa Diyos, pinangalanan ni Hagar ang
balon bilang parangal sa "The One Who Lives and Sees Me."

HAMON

Sinasabi sa atin ng mundo na "beauty is in the eye of the beholder." Ang Bibliya ay nagtuturo ng isang bagay na higit na nakahihigit sa kagandahan at ito ay: kapag ang Diyos ang iyong minamasdan, ang biyaya ay nasa mata ng iyong Nagmamasid. Alam Niya kung ano ang iyong pinagdaanan; alam Niya ang pinagdadaanan mo. Mga ina, hindi kayo kailanman hindi nakikita ng Diyos. Magtiwala sa Kanya na Siyang nakakakita sa iyo. ■
