MISSIONS MONTH SERIES: SET APART AND SENT OFF SEPTEMBER 10-11, 2022

Messiah's Missionaries

ACTS 13:13-25

Like the early ancient church at Antioch, GCF today is a missionary-sending church. We pray we can send out more specially designated missionaries.

We who are in Christ are all His missionary servants. Like Paul and his team, you and I are set apart and sent by God to our personal mission field: home, workplace, and communities. Wherever God has placed us today, we proclaim the message of salvation in our Messiah.

Main Truth: Trusting in God's providence, plans and promises, missionaries humbly proclaim Christ.

PLAN TRUSTING GOD'S PROVIDENCE AND SUPERINTENDENCE (Acts 13:13–16)
 God superintends the mission. Plans and strategies adjust to God's providential leading.

Principle: Missionaries stand ready to respond to however way God providentially works.

Application: What plan is God putting in your heart regarding our church's desire to send out more missionaries? What is your strategy to reach your personal mission field for Jesus? How ready are you to trust God as you respond to open opportunities and discouraging developments?

2. PROCLAIM GOD'S PROMISE OF SALVATION (Acts 13:17-23)

God's purpose is to redeem a people for Himself. He will redeem creation marred by sin. We see God's person, i.e. character, as He fulfills His promises and as His purposes unfold.

Principle: Missionaries trust God's person, purposes, and promises.

Application: How does your knowledge of God's character, plans, purposes and promises impact your attitude and actions towards mission work- of the church and in your personal mission field?

3. POINT GOD'S PEOPLE TO THE SAVIOR (Acts 13:24-25)

The missionary's responsibility is to humbly point people to Christ and prepare them to receive Him.

Principle: Missionaries humbly point people to Christ.

Application: What changes does God need to do in our hearts so that we will have the burden to humbly point others to Jesus?

FINAL THOUGHTS

The church sets apart, sends, and supports specially designated missionaries. We pray GCF can send out more servants to proclaim the Savior.

As disciples of Christ, we are all His missionaries. Wherever God puts us we must proclaim Jesus. We share the gospel of salvation in Christ confident of God's person, providence, purpose, and promise. Together, with our lives and our words, we humbly point people to Christ, praying they repent and believe the Savior and obey the Lord.

Imagine how great the advance of God's kingdom if we not only send out missionaries but also move as Messiah's missionaries anywhere we are!
